Exclusive spa, golf course, pools, and restaurants — wellness and premium hospitality all in one centralised location.

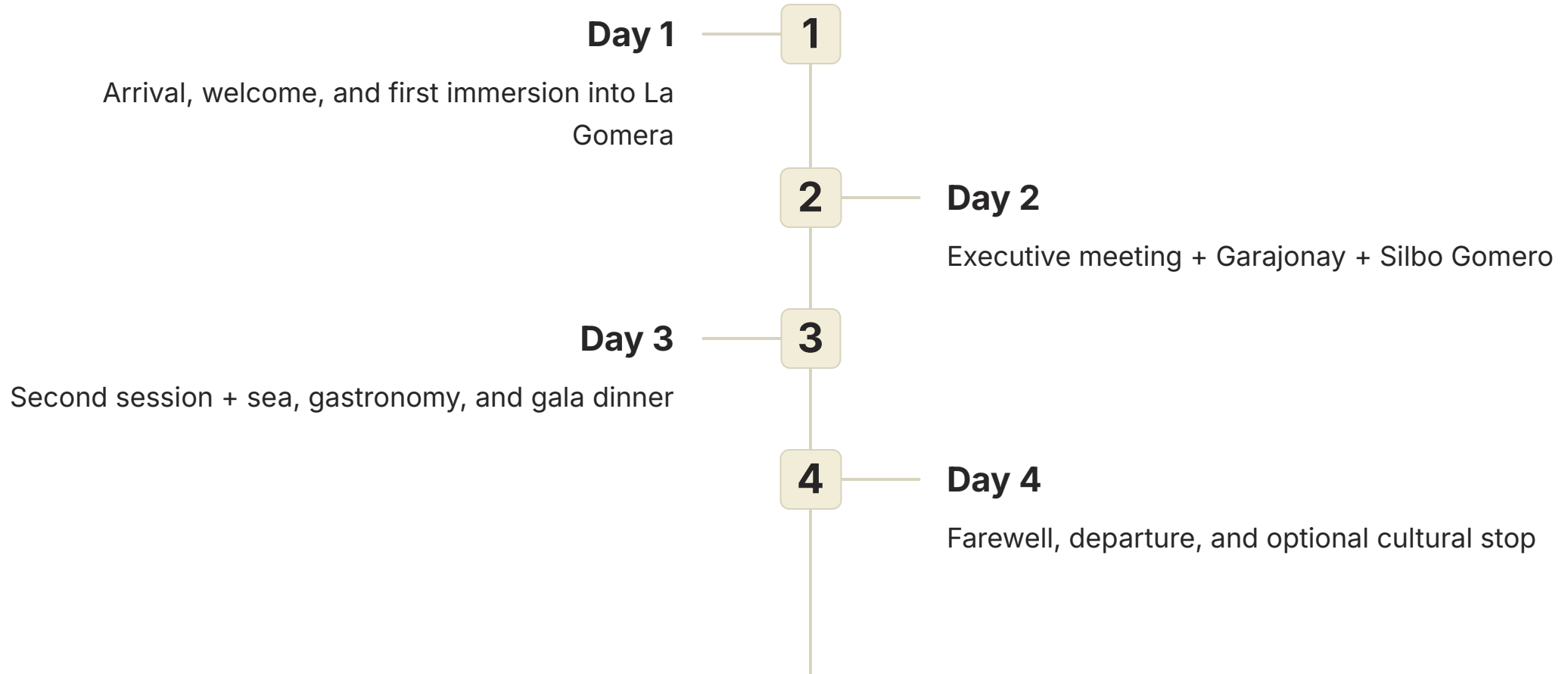

# Four days, one transformative experience



Each day combines high-level meetings with unique sensory and cultural experiences on the island.



# Day 1 — Arrival, Welcome and First Immersion

## Tailored Welcome

VIP reception at Tenerife South Airport, luggage assistance, and private transfer to Los Cristianos port. Fast ferry crossing of approximately 50 minutes to San Sebastián de La Gomera, followed by panoramic transfer to Playa de Santiago and check-in at Hotel Jardín Tecina.

## Welcome drink & first connection

Welcome moment with views of the Atlantic Ocean and Mount Teide: Gomera cheeses, almogrote, palm honey, Canary Island wines, and local welcome snacks — a first sensory immersion on the island.

## Dinner "Flavours of La Gomera"

Relaxed dinner in one of the hotel's private spaces or terraces, designed to encourage networking. Premium option: acoustic Canary Island music or a short introduction by a local expert: *"La Gomera, the island that can be heard."*

## Day 2

# Executive meeting + Garajonay + Living Culture

### Productive morning

Flexible working session tailored to the group profile — private boardroom for Boards of Directors, plenary session with breakout rooms for executive teams, or an inspirational keynote or workshop for incentive groups.

Themed coffee break: "**Tropical fruits, local pastries, and Canary Island coffee.**"

### High-impact afternoon

**Garajonay National Park** — private guided interpretive walk through the laurel forest (monteverde), a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stops at emblematic viewpoints with explanation of horizontal rain, ravines, and the island ecosystem.

**Silbo Gomero** — private demonstration of the whistled language recognised by UNESCO as Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity, with an interactive mini-workshop and a corporate message "whistled" as a symbolic closing moment.

- Dinner at a traditional restaurant or private venue with a Gomera-inspired menu: almogrote, watercress stew, island fish, palm honey, and Canary Island wines.

# Day 3 — Sea, Gastronomy, and Celebration



## Option A · La Gomera from the Sea

Boat trip from Playa de Santiago with views of the cliffs, swimming stop if weather allows, and aperitif on board — a unique perspective of the island.



## Option B · Golf & Wellness

The resort's wellness environment and golf course, ideal for an executive or premium incentive group looking for a more relaxed and restorative afternoon.



## Option C · Villages and Viewpoints

Tour through places such as Agulo, Hermigua, or Valle Gran Rey — adapted to the group's timing and logistics for a deep cultural immersion.

## **A high-protocol evening**

Welcome cocktail with soft live music, seated dinner in a private hotel space or unique venue — natural decoration with palm leaves, wood, volcanic stone, and warm lighting. Final speech, awards or recognition moments for incentive groups, and a special closing: stargazing, final drink on a terrace, or after-dinner lounge.

## **Concept menu: Gomera and Atlantic tradition**

Almogrote, watercress stew, local cheeses, island fish, palm honey, and Canary Island wines — a tasting menu with a strong local identity and a genuine story behind every dish.

# Day 4 — Closing and Farewell

## High-value wrap-up

For executive groups: final session — "**Key takeaways & next steps**" — to consolidate agreements and define strategic commitments before departure.

For incentive groups: relaxed breakfast at the hotel with a carefully selected local gift from La Gomera.

## Farewell from La Gomera

Assisted check-out and transfer to San Sebastián de La Gomera. Ferry to Tenerife and connection with flights from Tenerife South Airport. Optional depending on flight times: short stop in San Sebastián de La Gomera to discover the historic centre and the island's Columbian heritage.
