Set in a meticulously restored 1915 mansion on Plaza de Santa Ana in Vegueta — the founding quarter of Las Palmas — steps from the Cathedral, the Casa de Colón, and the Canarian Museum.

Belvedere Terrace

Intimate rooftop terrace with panoramic views over the Cathedral of Santa Ana, the historic plaza, and the Town Hall — an ideal setting for a private welcome cocktail or board reception.

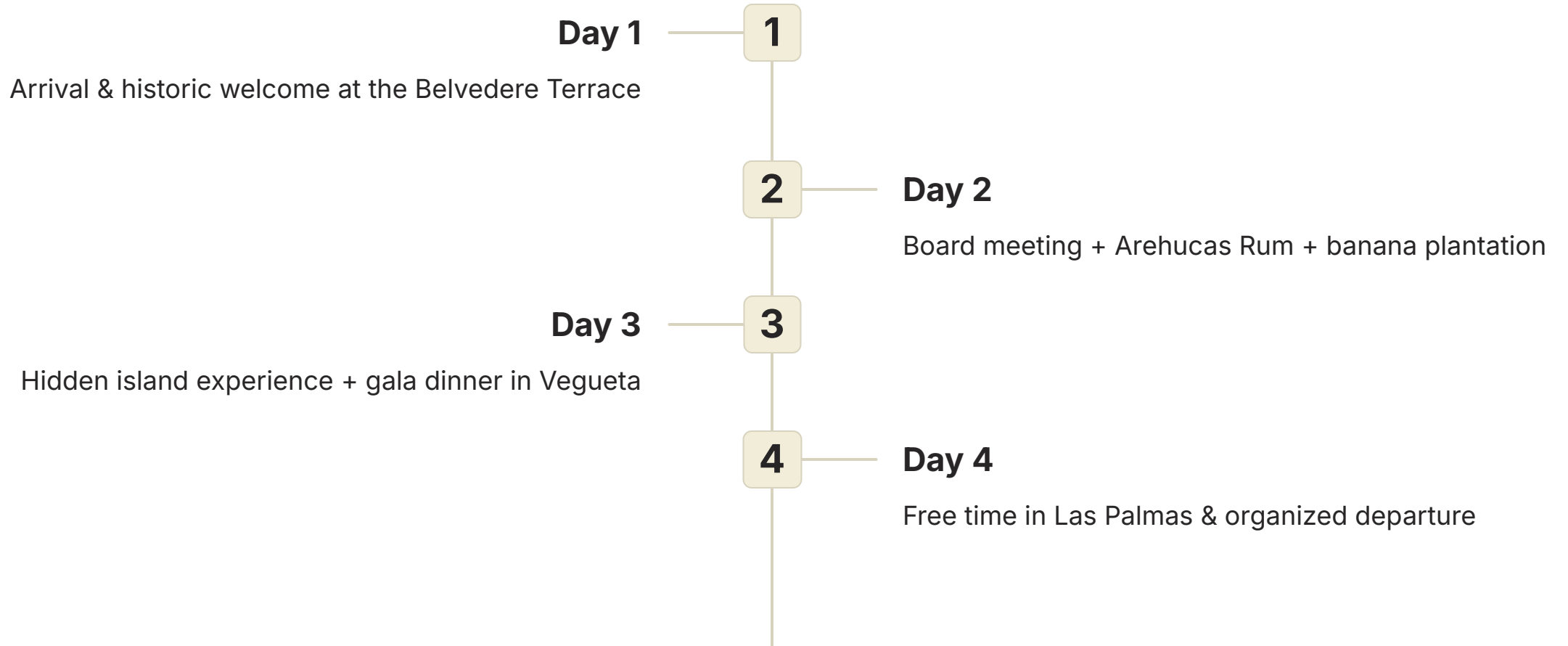
Boutique meeting intimacy

Program structure

Four days, one transformative experience



Each day combines high-level meetings with unique cultural, gastronomic, and natural experiences on the island.

Day 1 — Arrival & Historic Welcome



Tailored Welcome

Personalized reception with MICevents hostesses, hospitality desk, and private transfers from Gran Canaria Airport to Hotel Cordial Santa Ana in the heart of Vegueta, Las Palmas de Gran Canaria.

Welcome cocktail at the Belvedere Terrace

Intimate rooftop welcome with local products, Canarian wines, and Atlantic-inspired bites — with the Cathedral of Santa Ana as the backdrop, a first immersion into the island's flavors and historic soul.

Dinner "Gran Canaria: hidden stories"

Private dinner at the hotel or a selected Vegueta restaurant. Warm setting, local Canarian music, and the opening message: Gran Canaria as an island of hidden stories, flavors, and landscapes.

Day 2

Board meeting + Rum & Banana Plantation

Productive morning

Flexible working session tailored to the group profile — plenary session with breakout rooms, strategic workshops, or a motivational kick-off in the hotel's intimate and discreet meeting environment.

Theme coffee break "**Flavors of the north**": local cheeses, tropical fruits, artisan pastries, and specialty coffees from the Canarian tradition.

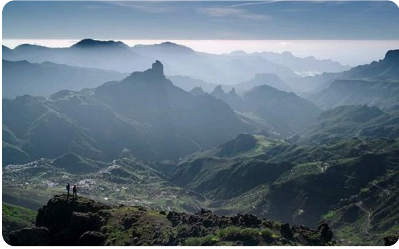
Immersive afternoon

Arehucas Rum Distillery — a visit to one of Gran Canaria's most emblematic industrial heritage sites, discovering the history of local rum production, sugar cane traditions, and the distillation process.

Hacienda La ReKompensa — a unique cultural and gastronomic experience at a working banana plantation in the north of the island.

Day 3 — Hidden Island Experience



Summit Experience (Option A)

A journey into the island's volcanic interior — mountain landscapes, dramatic viewpoints, traditional villages, and local specialties: cheese, honey, and almond-based delicacies.



Agaete Valley & Coffee (Option B)

A cultural and gastronomic route through the northwest — towns such as Gáldar and Santa María de Guía — culminating in a visit to one of Europe's only coffee plantations with a tasting experience.



Northern Coast & Canarian Lunch

A traditional Canarian lunch at a local restaurant, followed by a scenic stop along the dramatic northern coastline — a powerful contrast between rural interior and wild Atlantic shore.

Gala night — Day 3

"Secrets of Gran Canaria: The Gala"



A high-protocol evening

Welcome cocktail at dusk on the Belvedere Terrace of Hotel Cordial Santa Ana, followed by a seated gala dinner at **Pueblo Canario** in Las Palmas — an authentic cultural venue inspired by traditional Canarian architecture — with corporate speeches, recognition moments, and live local music.

Concept menu: Atlantic, tradition, and land

Local fish, Canarian cheeses, mojo sauces, tropical fruit, almond and honey-based desserts, and carefully selected local wines — a tribute to Gran Canaria's agricultural and gastronomic heritage.

Day 4 — Free Time & Farewell

Optional morning experiences

For board & executive groups: a brief closing session — **"Key takeaways & next steps"** — to consolidate agreements and define strategic commitments, held in the intimate setting of the hotel.

For incentive groups: relaxed breakfast with a carefully selected local gift rooted in Gran Canaria's gastronomy and culture.

Farewell in Vegueta

Free time to explore the historic quarter at leisure: the Plaza de Santa Ana, the Casa de Colón, the Canarian Museum, the Triana shopping street, or a seaside walk along Las Canteras beach. Staggered private transfers to Gran Canaria Airport with MICevents assistance at each departure.
